**RESOLUTION NO. 26-4
A RESOLUTION OF Klondike Canyon Geological Hazard Abatement District
AUTHORIZING THE ADOPTION OF THE
2026 PALOS VERDES PENINSULA MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN**

WHEREAS, all of KCGHAD has exposure to natural hazards that increase the risk to life, property, environment, and economy; and

WHEREAS, pro-active mitigation of known hazards before a disaster event can reduce or eliminate long-term risk to life and property; and

WHEREAS, The Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (Public Law 106-390) established new requirements for pre- and post-disaster hazard mitigation programs; and

WHEREAS, the KCGHAD has completed a planning process that engages the public, assesses the risk and vulnerability to the impacts of natural hazards, develops a mitigation strategy consistent with a set of uniform goals, and creates a plan for implementing, evaluating, and revising this strategy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the KCGHAD:

- 1.) Adopts in its entirety, Volume I and the KCGHAD annex of Volume II of the 2026 Palos Verdes Peninsula Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan.
- 2.) Will use the adopted and approved portions of the Hazard Mitigation Plan to guide pre- and post- disaster mitigation of the hazards identified.
- 3.) Will coordinate the strategies identified in the Hazard Mitigation Plan with other planning programs and mechanisms under its jurisdictional authority.
- 4.) Will continue its support of the on-going area-wide mitigation efforts and continue to participate in the Planning Partnership as described by the Hazard Mitigation Plan.
- 5.) Will help to promote and support the mitigation successes of all Planning Partners.
